


CYBERAMA

PASS: ○○○○○○○○○○○○○○○


- ✓ 8 - 15 digits length

Talk to your trusted adult for rules to follow




Little johnny wants to play online,

Stop and think, instead of putting your security at risk.


A sneaky malware known as spyware




Advertisement supporting software, called Adware

Making your family upset and worrisome


The Internet has stuff that is good and bad

someone naïve or someone malicious and tall?


Observe you, tracks you, steals your info, and mimic you


Food, energy, finance, emergency ,

Forgive a mistake and educate, or retaliate?


